MICHAL TO NEW HOPE



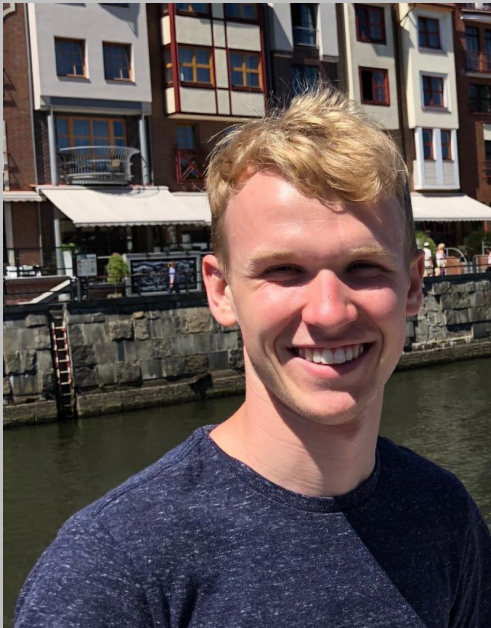

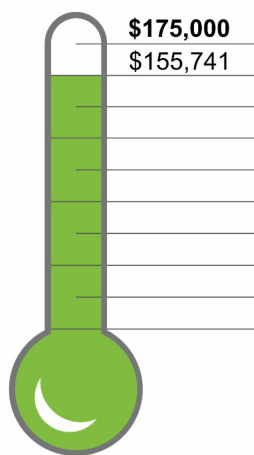


TOMAHAWK CHRISTIAN CHURCH

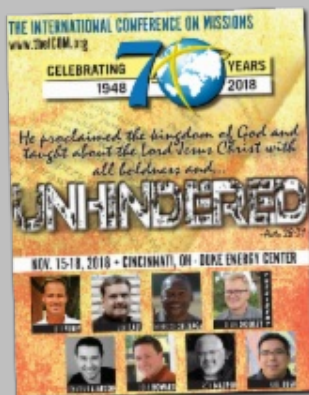
