Our second tour was in southern Poland. Church leaders from Christ's Church in Jacksonville, FL, Tomoka Christian Church in Ormond Beach, FL, Central Christian Church in Ocala, FL. and the Cumberland Christian Church in Cumberland, IN, flew into Krakow and joined us as we traveled to Pawełki (CSM), Sosnowiec, Dabrowa Górnicza, Katowice, Pabianice, Łódż, Zakosciele, and Tomaszów Mazowiecki, Each church expressed a desire to reach out to their community and it was exciting to see how it was happening through Teen Challenge, youth outreaches, mom's groups at a café, and more. It is wonderful to pray together, share leadership principles, fellowship around the table, and grow in relationship with our Polish partners.
