Some restrictions have been lifted, e.g., parks and forests are now open, but social distancing is still enforced and face masks are required when going out to essential places. The Polish borders remain closed to foreigners indefinitely. Our plans to walk these streets in just a few short weeks have been postponed. We miss you, Poland, and hope to see you soon!
