#### **UKRAINIAN REFUGEE ASSISTANCE**



In October, PCM sent \$5,100 to Poland for the purpose of Ukrainian refugee relief:

1) Food distribution centers in Poland - \$2,800

- 2) Polish churches for housing/food \$1,800
- 3) Transports to Ukraine from Polish churches \$500

PCM is committed to sending funds to help our Polish churches provide food and housing for Ukrainian refugees. Every donation is deeply appreciated. Thank you for your kindness, generosity and prayers.


