## UKRAINIAN REFUGEE ASSISTANCE



It's been three and a half years since the Russian aggression began in 2022, yet our Polish churches continue to find ways to provide assistance. Pastor Leslaw Juszcyszyn from the Pulawska church in Warsaw just returned from delivering needed supplies to territories deep inside Ukraine. Evangelical believers close to the front then distribute the supplies to soldiers and civilians. We are thankful for the cooperation between churches and the assistance of Dobro Czynic and others to make these deliveries possible.





The "South" church in Warsaw continues to provide food and supplies for Ukrainians living in Warsaw through their distribution center. Recently, they hosted a special program to celebrate Ukraine's Independence Day. We are so thankful for the way the Polish churches continue to bless and bring encouragement to the Ukrainian people.
