

HELP FOR UKRAINIAN REFUGEES



As Ukrainian refugees flood into Poland, our Polish ministry partners are responding to the need in big ways. Ostroda Camp in NE Poland has been transformed into a refugee center, and as of this writing, 50+ refugees have arrived with many more to come (up to 180 total). The camp was recently featured on Polish television (see picture above of the celebration at the camp for the 10-yr-old refugee who arrived on her birthday). Several of our Polish churches are housing refugees in their churches and in the homes of their people. Buses have been sent to the border to receive refugees. We have been doing our best to connect the requests we receive with those who can meet those needs. A big THANK YOU to the U.S. churches and 100+ individuals who have already given to the "Ukrainian refugee" fund. We are amazed at the overwhelming response and pray blessing on all those who have given. The needs are enormous, so we hope funds will continue as together we reach out in the name of Jesus to care for those in crisis. Plock as they need assistance in paying off a \$235,000 loan for their new building. ... Ciechanow as they seek to raise \$53,000 by September 2022 to insulate their building.
