

HELP FOR UKRAINIAN REFUGEES - UPDATE #2

OSTRODA CAMP



- Ostroda Camp is housing 185 refugees and have found placements in local homes for 7 additional families.
- Their focus now is caring for the physical and emotional needs of the refugees.
- Polish language classes are being offered for every age group.
- Volunteers provide a variety of activities, e.g., art projects, sports/games, etc.
- Due to the large number of local donations of goods, a separate drop-off site has been established within the city limits, which also helps protect the privacy and well-being of the refugees living at the camp.
- Ostroda Camp is collecting large pallets of goods and coordinating efforts to send truckloads of these supplies to Ukraine.

POLISH CHURCHES



- PCM has sent funds to several of our Polish churches who are reaching out in various ways to house and assist Ukrainian refugees.
- Sandomierz has beds for 20; Bielsk Podlaski currently is housing 32 (one
 Ukrainian woman was baptized on Sunday); Dabrowa Gornicza's first group of
 children have moved to Germany and another group has arrived; Ostroda church
 is housing 21 in their building plus additional families in local flats; Sosnowiec,
 Ciechanow, Olsztyn, Plock, Gdynia, and Kolobrzeg are all housing and/or caring
 for Ukrainian refugee families.
- The Warsaw West church has become a refugee transfer center and has transported and placed 800 refugees thus far. They hope to set up modules on a piece of property south of Warsaw to house 100 families.
- The Lublin church is helping find housing for hundreds of refugees both in Poland and beyond and are collecting truckloads of goods to send to Ukraine.
- The Pulawska Street church in Warsaw has become a reception center, offering food, information, and warm shelter for those arriving in central Warsaw.
- The Warsaw South church has established a logistics and collection center for goods to send to Ukrainians in a 2500-meter hall in their building.
- The Wilanow church in Warsaw have helped place 100 refugees and are seeking to acquire a 100-room hotel to house additional refugee families.
- The Biala Podlaska church is close to the border and is donating goods/funds to help the huge number of refugees and wounded Ukrainian soldiers in their city.
