Our initial goal of raising \$300,000 in three years (2020-2022) was realized, but the needs were still great. We rejoice to report that the total realized after these three years is:

\$431,764.81.

PLEASE GIVE

PCM is seeking to provide \$100,000 per month for the first three months of 2023 for Ukrainian refugee relief in Poland and Ukraine through our Polish churches.

- Distribution centers: \$30K/month for food
- Ostróda Camp, Polish churches, other housing: \$40K/month for food/utilities
- Transports to Ukraine from various Polish cities: \$30K/month to send 30 tons of food.
