ONGOING MINISTRY TO UKRAINIAN REFUGEES

The distribution center for Ukrainian refugees at the Bemowo shopping mall in Warsaw is still serving 600+ families on a weekly basis. Several of our Polish churches are still housing refugees in their buildings as well as caring for others in local apartments and homes. Regular transports of food and medical supplies are being delivered into many different cities in Ukraine by our Polish partners.



The situation in Ukraine is intense and many are without electricity and the basic necessities of life. Please continue to pray.



HI-PLAINS SCHOOL OF MISSIONS

We are so thankful for the opportunity we had to participate in the Hi-Plains School of Missions, directed by Marvin Garrison. During three weeks in October, we visited sixteen churches in Oklahoma, Texas, and Kansas. These churches are not yet PCM supporters, so it was a wonderful opportunity to present the work of PCM and make new friends. We were so blessed by this experience and are encouraged knowing that these churches are now aware of the needs and are praying for the churches in Poland.

Our initial goal of raising \$300,000 in three years (2020-2022) for church buildings, the school of music, and scholarships was realized, but the needs were still great. Thus, we extended our goal to \$400,000 by the end of 2022. We rejoice to report that to date we have received \$419,294.81. Thank you to all those who have given. Of course, funds are



still needed for buildings and scholarships, so we will continue to dream big for Poland.
