

Although the Camelback Christian Church in Scottsdale, AZ, has supported PCM for many years, this was the first time we had the opportunity to share in their worship service. We


are thankful for Mark and Debbie Hollenbach and all the congregation as they make Jesus known both locally and abroad.

PCM has committed to sending funds to help our Polish churches and Ostroda Camp provide food and housing for Ukrainian refugees. Every donation is deeply appreciated.


